Looking for a forum in which to discuss those questions you never felt comfortable asking? Want a safe place to explore your Judaism? New students are welcome to join our year long Tuesday morning classes at any time.

The first hour class will be taught by Rabbi Mordecai Kieffer and is entitled *The Book of Leviticus*. Rabbi Kieffer will explore how the sacrifices of animals, grains, and wines yielded a high pinnacle of holiness and deep spirituality for ancient Israel and what a modern Jew can learn from the past in his/her search for holiness and spirituality.

New Bureau CEO, David Lewis, will teach the 2nd hour class entitled *Jewish Answers to Ultimate Questions*, where students will search our ancient texts and the writings of some of the great modern Jewish thinkers (Buber, Heschel, Kaplan, Soloveichik) for answers to the seemingly "unanswerable". Does God exist? What does it mean to be in a relationship with God? Why is there evil? What happens after I die? Who wrote the Torah? Intertwined with 3500 years of Jewish perspectives on these vital questions, participants will have an opportunity to articulate their own answers and personal reflections on these timeless questions.

Choose either one or both classes which run from 9:15 to 10:15 a.m. and 10:30 to 11:30 a.m. beginning September 16th, 2008.
